						This certificate was issued pursuant to the Civil Affairs Regulations promulgated by Royal Decree no. M/7 dated 4/20/1407 H [12/22/1986 AD]

Important Instructions:

- 1- This certificate is dispensed to every newborn after registration in the Civil Status registries.
- 2- Upon receiving this certificate, the newborn's guardian must complete the following basic vaccinations:
 - Upon birth, "first dose of tuberculosis + hepatitis B".
 - After 6 weeks "first dose of triple bacterial and polio + second dose of hepatitis B"
 - After 3 months "second dose of triple bacterial and polio"
 - After 5 months " third dose of triple bacterial and polio".
 - After 6 months "primary dose of measles + third dose of hepatitis B".
 - After 12 months " triple viral + booster dose of measles + primary dose of mumps + primary dose of Rubella".
- 3- Upon completion of the basic vaccinations, the guardian must check with the Civil Status to obtain the basic certificate, after which the following vaccinations must be completed:
 - After 18 months, "first booster dose of triple bacterial and polio".
 - After 4-6 years "second booster dose of triple bacterial and polio + hepatitis to those who hadn't been vaccinated".
- 4- This certificate must be kept from any tampering or forging or negligence, and in case of loss, it must be reported immediately to the nearest civil status department.
- 5- This certificate must be handed to the designated party upon checking to obtain the basic certificate.
